1. GENERAL INFORMATION

Hong Chi Association (the "Association") is a charitable organisation engaged in promoting the welfare of people with intellectual disabilities in Hong Kong. Its registered office is at Pinehill Village, Chung Nga Road, Nam Hang, Tai Po, New Territories, Hong Kong.

Pursuant to the approval letter dated on 23 August 2019, the Government approved a grant to the Association in respect of "Shining Road Life Planning Scheme" (the "Scheme"). The Scheme lasted for 36 months from 1 September 2019 to 31 August 2022.

The objective of the Scheme is to promote the diversified and personalized career planning projects to meet the needs of mentally handicapped students and cultivate them to know their own specialties, enhance their understanding of life planning and encourage their participation of the business community, which support them to join the society in the future.
