Hong Chi Volunteer Team is dedicated to providing 8,000 hours of community services in the 2 years ahead.

❤️本會於11月12日正式成立了匡智義 工隊,由逾1,000名屬校學生、成人服務 單位的學員、家長及職員組成的36個支 隊,將四出服務社會上有需要人士,以秉 承本會「回饋社會關愛」的服務精神,從 中亦讓市民認識智障人士的能力。匡智義 工更會夥拍企業友好行善,務求加大義務 工作的規模和力度。

義工隊在社會福利署大埔及北區福 利專員余廖美儀女士、深水埗區助理福利 專員梁世昌先生和高級社會工作主 任(義務工作)陳幹恒先生,以及 教育局高級學校發展主任(大埔) 郭陳寶蓮女士的見證下誕生,並隨 即在大埔松嶺村進行了首個社會服 務日,招待了30多個來自深水埗 區的家庭,透過攤位遊戲、自助午 餐及由導師聯同學員主持的糕餅製 作、陶藝製作、有機種植和花藝設 計等多個工作坊,讓大小朋友度過 充實愉快的一天。

Hong Chi Volunteer Team was established on 12th November, with 36 sub-teams formed by over 1,000 special school students, adult service units' trainees, their parents and staff, all ready to reach out to serve the needy at large. This, in accordance with the Association's spirit of "Giving Back to Society", will also give the community a better understanding of the abilities of intellectually challenged people. The Team will join hands with corporate friends for enhancing the scope and impact of volunteer services.

Witnessed by the Social Welfare Department's District Social Welfare Officer (Tai Po/North), Mrs Elaine Yue, Assistant District Social Welfare Officer (Sham Shui Po), Mr Charles Leung, and Senior Social Work Officer (Volunteer Service), Mr Tommy Chan, as well as the Education Bureau's Senior School Development Officer (Tai Po), Mrs Kwok Chan Po-lin, the Team was born and delivered the first Community Service Day. At Pinehill Village, Tai Po, we warmly received over 30 families from the Sham Shui Po district. Through game booths, a buffet lunch and workshops on bakery, pottery, organic farming and floral arrangement skills, we brought these families a joyous and fruitful day.

感覺統合治療

感覺統合是指我們的身體將由視 覺、聽覺、觸覺、嗅覺和味覺,肌肉關 節的本體覺及前庭系統的平衡覺所接收 到的訊息,經神經系統傳送到腦幹部位 作分析及統合,再指揮身體各部份作出 適當的反應。感覺統合一旦遇到障礙, 便會出現「感統失調」。部分智障人士 及自閉症患者亦有感覺統合失調狀況, 他們的症狀各異,有的會不停搖動身 體,有的害怕與人有身體接觸或對聲音 特別敏感,不單影響日常訓練、工作和 社交,亦為家人和照顧者增添壓力。

為讓有需要的學員接受合適的感統 治療, 匡智山景中心設置了一間「感覺 統合治療室」,內有攀爬、搖盪、滑翔 等訓練設施,職業治療師將配合光效、 色差、影像和音效調控,為學員度身訂 造治療活動,並持之以恆地進行,以達 至更佳的治療效果。這所治療室得以成 立,實在有賴The Financial Markets Charitable Foundation透過2010及2011年「湯森路 透慈善高爾夫球日」為本會籌募 \$400,000,特此鳴謝。

Sensory Integration Training

Sensory Integrative Dysfunction (SID) is a neurological disorder which causes inability in an individual to filter and organize sensory information in a meaningful way. SID often is related to people with intellectual disabilities and autism. The commonly seen SID-induced behaviours such as uncontrollable body movements, aggressive reactions even to gentle touch and emotional outburst affect their training and work routines, their social life and family relationships.

To provide needy trainees with appropriate treatment against SID, Hong Chi Shan King Centre has set up the Sensory Integration Room, where there is equipment for climbing, rocking and gliding. Our Occupational Therapists will use the equipment plus different lighting, colour, visual and audio effects inside the Room to tailormake treatment for trainees. Such a Room was made possible thanks to the

generous sponsorship of \$400,000 from The Financial Markets Charitable Foundation, which was raised from the "Thomson Reuters Charity Golf Day" in 2010 and 2011.

Taiwan Exchange Programme on Rehabilitation Services

Thanks to the Social Welfare Department's Social Welfare Development Fund, a 4-day exchange visit to Taipei, Taiwan, was arranged for 15 staff members. They toured local pre-school centres, special schools, day activity centres, hostels, social enterprises and parents' self-help groups to learn about their successful experience in operating rehabilitation services. During a rehabilitation unit visit, they played games with the service users and taught them handicrafts, which echoed the Association's direction on contributing to society. An internal report-back session on the group's valuable gains from this exchange programme will soon be held.

- 為推動智障人士就業首度舉辦「匡智會職業復康服務巡禮」,吸引 逾30間企業的代表及近400位特殊學校師生及家長到場參觀
- 在2010/11年度,「玻璃樽回收行動」共回收約360公噸玻璃廢料, 舉行超過130次公眾教育活動
- 「2010/11匡智香港賽馬會全港中小學社區有機農耕比賽」錄得破紀錄的94間中、小及特殊學校參加
- 九龍及港島區聯網舉行「綠色行動嘉年華」,鼓勵市民保護環境
- 成立「匡智義工隊」,結集逾千名學員、學生、家長、員工及企業 友好的力量服務社群,回饋社會
- 持續舉辦多元化的職員培訓課程和海外交流團,以提升服務質素
- 匡智家長工作執委會舉行不同講座和活動,為家長增值
- 匡智成人步操樂團多次公開表演,為市民帶來視聽娛樂

Below is summary of the Association's accomplishments in 2010/2011:

Special Education & Children Service:

- Two schools were honoured with the "Chief Executive's Award for Teaching Excellence 2010/11"
- The 9th Mainland and Hong Kong Exchange Programme in Special Education, co-organized with the Department of Basic Education II of Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China, was held in Taiyuan, Shanxi with over a hundred of teaching professionals from different provinces attending
- Various professional development activities were organized for teaching and professional staff to further enhance their teaching quality
- An updated "Professional Service Manual" was issued by the District-based Speech Therapy Team (Tuen Mun & Tin Shui Wai)
- Installed Hong Kong's first domestic solar thermal heat pump system at Children Home for saving energy
- Promoted green lifestyles to enhance students' environmental awareness
- The first Joint School Sports Day was successfully held

Adult Service:

- The first "Hong Chi Career Showcase" was held to raise public awareness of the employment needs of people with intellectual disabilities. Over 30 caring corporations and 400 special school students, teachers and parents attended the event
- Around 360 tonnes of glass waste were recycled through the "Glass Bottle Recycling Campaign" and more than 130 public education activities were hosted in the year of 2010/11
- "2010/11 Hong Chi-Hong Kong Jockey Club Community Organic Farming Competition for Primary and Secondary Schools in Hong Kong" enrolled a record high of 94 secondary, primary and special schools
- Kowloon and Hong Kong Island Cluster organized the "Green Action Carnival" to appeal for public support in environmental conservation
- Set up "Hong Chi Volunteer Team" to enlist over 1,000 trainees, students, parents, staff and caring corporations' support in serving the community
- Organized a variety of staff development and overseas exchange programmes to enhance service standards
- Parents Work Committees organized talks and events to empower parents
- Hong Chi Adult Marching Band gave open performances to amuse the community

Social Enterprises:

- The Association's fifth social enterprise restaurant the HC Café (located on Tai Yuen Street, Wanchai) held its grand opening on 16th September 2011
- L'Oréal Hong Kong staff lounge "My Corner" is in service since August 2011
- Joined hands with ACCA for the first time to organize the "ACCA Hong Kong Business Competition 2011"

Public Education:

- Held the 8th "Hong Chi Climbathon" and recruited the most number of "Integration Team"
- Enlisted caring corporations, volunteers, trainees and students' support for the New Territories Flag Day to promote social integration
- Arranged volunteer activities to promote social acceptance of people with intellectual disabilities, while enhancing trainees' and students' interpersonal skills.
